<b>Language Certificate requirement</b>	Language certificate is Not requested. We rely on our partner institutes to ensure that students coming to study at MCU have a sufficient level of English or Mandarin to cope in an academic environment. It is advised students have a similar level of TOEFL IBT 61, IELTS 5 or TOEIC 550 for English-taught courses// TOCFL B2 level or HSK 4 for Chinese-taught courses.																
<b>School housing</b>	Students are accommodated in on or off-campus school housing. Fees vary from US\$500 to \$700 per term. Housing request is available after the student's application is approved. If students are interested, they can take courses provided in both Taipei and Taoyuan campuses. It usually takes 1.5~2 hours to commute between two campuses.																
<b>Application Deadline for Airport Pick-up and Dormitory</b>	Complete the Service Booking Form and return to us: Fall Semester: before July 30; Spring Semester: before December 31 ✧ <i>Please wait to confirm your flight ticket <u>only after</u> you receive the Letter of Acceptance issued by Ming Chuan University. We advise students not to buy plane tickets before the finalization of your entry visa in order to avoid costs due to cancellations or rescheduling.</i>

<b>Course enrollment procedure</b>	After arriving at MCU/ completing the registration, students can enroll, change, add or drop personal course selection on-line through Student System in the beginning of new semester. Students can take courses across different majors, year levels, and campuses. Please note that it may be difficult to get all the courses interested because limited number of seats available for popular classes.																
<b>Course load per semester</b>	<p>Most courses worth 2~3 credits, i.e. 2~3 classroom hours per week. A full-time student at MCU is strongly recommended to enroll in 9 credits at minimum and 25 credits at maximum per semester.</p> <p>MCU uses the US credit system: 1 Credit ⇄ 2 ECTS ⇄ 4 CATS</p>

## **Ming Chuan University Mandarin Studies & Culture Center Classes**

### **銘傳大學華語中心華語語學堂課程說明**

Here we would like to update you with the decision from the school committee regarding language classes provided by the Mandarin Studies & Culture Center (MSCC) of MCU.

Exchange/visiting students, who are interested in learning Chinese, can choose to attend language classes by MSCC. MSCC classes are available for Beginner level and/or Basic level, including 3-hour a day for 2 days, i.e. 6 hours in a week, continuing for 15 weeks during school semester. Total class hours are 90 per school semester. (MSCC is closed during winter and summer breaks.). Since learning Chinese is voluntary, not compulsory, students have free will to decide to join MSCC language classes or not. If choosing to attend, students will pay tuition for MSCC language classes, i.e. NT\$13,500 per person per semester, paid in NT dollars after arriving at MCU.

If students have no intention for fee-paying MSCC language classes, they can enroll in 3-credit Basic/ or Intermediate Mandarin course offered by the International College curriculum. This class runs 3-hour per week during the semester. Because it is part of the International College curriculum, there is no additional tuition fees if student is taking this option with International College curriculum.

來訪的交換/訪問學生如果有興趣學習華語，可以選擇本校華語中心提供的華語語學堂，課程程度以華語零程度或是初級程度學生為主，一周兩天/一天 3 小時/一周共 6 小時，每學期 15 周課程共計上課 90 小時（華語中心寒假、暑假不上課）。學生可自己選擇是否參加華語語學堂，選擇上華語語學堂課程者應支付學費，華語語學堂學費每人每學期新台幣 NT\$13,500(共計上課 90 小時)，抵達銘傳大學支付新台幣現金。

若交換/訪問學生沒有意願付費參加華語中心華語語學堂，可選擇國際學院開設 3 學分基礎或中級華語課，國際學院每周 3 小時(3 學分)的華語課程不需支付學費。
