Department of Theology

The Department of Theology instructs students on the principles of theology that are founded on the proactive and innovative pastoral ideologies of Rev. Yonggi Cho and orthodox evangelist Christianity. In doing so, we continue the traditions of Pentecostal Theology while further establishing and expanding Full Gospel Theology. Through comprehensive spirituality training programs, we provide a balanced education aimed at cultivating spiritual leaders who will guide churches not only in South Korea but also worldwide. To achieve this, the Department of Theology's track programs are built on Biblical Theology and offer a systematic approach to theoretical theology, emphasizing the development of Full Gospel leaders equipped with Pentecostal spirituality.

Theology Track

The theology track trains spiritual leaders and pastors who are endowed with a Christian worldview, as well as the character and abilities of Christ. To achieve this, the programs are based on the faith of Rev. Yonggi Cho while also providing teachings on orthodox evangelicalism, the general theology of Pentecostal Christianity, and various spiritual training programs.

Through this approach, we educate our students to accurately deliver the Word of God to the world and equip them with the leadership skills needed to become global leaders.

Career Paths after Graduation

Students may proceed to the graduate school after their graduation to obtain a master's degree or a doctoral degree and choose careers as pastors, missionaries, theologians, chaplains, or social workers.

Counseling Track

The counseling track trains Christian counseling professionals equipped with the counseling and educational skills needed in South Korean churches and society through Christian education and counseling. Graduates may serve as youth ministers or professional counselors with a Christian worldview in various counseling fields.

Career Paths after Graduation

Students may obtain a professional counselor license and find a career as a professional counselor, Christian counselor, minister for children and adolescents, cultural minister, or missionary.



Department of Nursing

The Department of Nursing equips our students with the skills and attitude of serving and compassion, along with practical knowledge of scientific nursing to prevent diseases among individuals, families, and communities and promote health, recovery, and well-being. Through this process, we train nursing professionals with global competitiveness, Christian faith, academic knowledge, and nursing skills. Our field-oriented programs are designed to ensure that graduates can adapt to the field of nursing as soon as possible. To support this, we have established practical training agreements with Yongin Severance Hospital, Gangbuk Samsung Hospital, Hanyang University Hospital, Bundang Cha Medical University Hospital, Hanrim University Seongshim Hospital, and more. Additionally, we design our educational programs to develop the core competencies required for nursing excellence.

Career Paths after Graduation

Our graduates take the national license exam to obtain a South Korean nurse's license and find jobs in university hospitals, general hospitals, and other medical institutions, as well as industrial businesses as nurses. They can also serve as midwives or health management professionals in educational institutions, research institutions, health-related government agencies, infirmaries, nursing homes, and other elderly-related facilities. Also, they can obtain a US nursing license (NCLEX-RN) to work as international nurses or open businesses such as midwife services, elderly nursing facilities, social rehabilitation facilities, child welfare centers, etc.

School of Social Science

Social science is a branch of science that analytically, comprehensively, and scientifically studies the specific and realistic problems present in society, ultimately developing the skills needed to resolve real-life issues. The importance of social science in a knowledge-based society is becoming increasingly significant, and it is expected that career opportunities for social science majors will expand in the future. The School of Social Science consists of the Department of Media & Visual Advertisement, the Department of Business Administration, and the Department of Tourism Management, where students can obtain in-depth knowledge and professional skills through a balanced educational program.



Department of Media & Visual Advertising

The Department's educational programs aim to train media content professionals who are equipped with expertise and practical skills to lead the world in the era of smart media. Our programs are designed with an emphasis on practical expertise. Based on a Christian worldview, the department strives to train visual media experts in a global era by learning theories of communication and practical knowledge. Students in this program will build a theoretical foundation and gain field experience through internships in media-related industries such as news agencies, advertising, and PR industries, etc. This approach enables students to grow into independent professionals capable of shaping their own futures while mastering the marketing skills needed to plan, produce, and distribute digital content in the smart media era. Our passionate faculty, recognized as the best in South Korea, are dedicated to making this vision a reality. The Department of Media & Visual Advertising offers two advanced major tracks: the Media Visual Major and the Advertisement & PR Major.



Career Paths after Graduation

Graduates from the Media & Visual Major find their career paths as reporters, VJs, editors, announcers, web planners/administrators, PR planners/managers, or writers.

Graduates with a major in Advertising and Public Relations find jobs as AEs in ad agencies, PDs, copywriters, creative directors, or marketing managers in digital media companies, business in general, public agencies, or advertisement agencies.

Department of Business Administration



The Department of Business Administration aims to educate creative and ethical business managers and professionals who will lead the development of the community and the nation. We help our students to develop analytical skills, insight, creativity, and other professional business management skills to resolve various issues they will face in business administration, as well as convergent skills required to manage a business in the era of the 4th Industrial Revolution. The educational programs in the department include basic education for the major, marketing, HR/organization management, finance and accounting, production and logistics, global business management strategies, business information systems, and other in-depth education programs for each segment of Business Administration. Notably, we offer advanced major track programs for the digital and accounting segments. Students in our department have opportunities to study abroad, engage in field experiences, and participate in internships, enabling them to shape their futures with the support of our distinguished faculty members.

Career Paths after Graduation

Graduates from the Digital & Marketing Track can obtain professional certifications and pursue careers as social survey analysts, marketing and service managers, ERP and logistics managers, social media experts, big data and IoT analysts, or specialists in other fields. They can find employment in large corporations, international companies, venture startups, public agencies, and more.

Graduates from the International Business Management Track are well-positioned to pursue careers in domestic and international businesses, multinational corporations, financial institutions, public agencies, and consulting firms that provide businesses with global knowledge. They can also explore opportunities in international organizations or find a diplomatic career as well.

Graduates from the Finance and Accounting Track may find a career path as a civil servant (central-local tax professional, accounting professional, or customs officer, etc.), a licensed professional (CPA, tax accountant, appraiser, customs attorney, business consultant, etc.), or a financial professional (in banks, securities companies, or insurance companies). They can also get a job in any business and play an active role in the field of their expertise (planning, accounting, treasury, finance, etc.).



Department of Tourism Management



The Department of Tourism Management aims to train professionals in tourism industries, which are the high-value-added, strategic industries of the future. The students learn theories and receive practical training in various areas of tourism industries, such as hotels, tourism agencies, airlines, convention businesses, or dining industries, to become competent tourism professionals equipped with both theoretical and practical skills.

In addition to the introductory courses for the major, such as Introduction to Tourism and Tourism Resources, we provide in-depth programs such as Hotel Management, Tourism Service Marketing, Cultural Tourism, Convention Management, Dining Management, Airline Management, Airline Ticketing, Global Product Development, and more. In line with the changing environment in the tourism industry, our student study ESG sustainable tourism and IT & tourism. Through field trips to domestic and overseas tourist destinations, field training, and internships, we help our students become tourism professionals equipped with both knowledge and practical competencies. In addition, students benefit from exemptions from written exams for government-recognized licenses□ such as Tourist Interpreter, Domestic Tour Guide, Hotel Service Provider, and Hotel Manager□for subjects related to their majors. After graduation, students can pursue careers as a tourist Interpreter/guide, domestic tour guide, travel product planner, cultural tour guide, hotel service provider, hotel manager, airline cabin crew member, ground staff member, airport customs officer, international meeting planner, event planner, casino dealer, cruise ship staff member, international medical tourism coordinator, and more.

Career Paths after Graduation

The Tourism & Airline Track aims to train general tourism and airline professionals, and graduates may find career paths with a Tourist Interpreter/Guide or Domestic Tour Guide License to find jobs at travel agencies, OTAs, domestic and international airlines, theme parks, leisure businesses, casino businesses, Korea Tourism Organization, government agencies related to tourism, research institutes, etc.

The Hotel & Convention Track trains the students as professionals in the hotel and convention industries. Students may obtain licenses as a hotel service provider, hotel manager, convention planner, etc., to find job opportunities at hotels, resorts, international meeting planning businesses, convention and exhibition businesses, dining businesses, etc.



School of Public Services

The government and the public sector are playing an increasingly significant role in addressing the numerous issues arising in the country and local communities. This is due to the rapid advancement of state-of-the-art intelligence and information technologies, as well as the progress of the 4th Industrial Revolution. The School of Public Services comprises the Department of Police Administration and the Department of Social Welfare, aiming to train professionals who provide customized public services to the citizens while resolving various social issues and enhancing efficiency in the operation and management of the public sector.

Department of Police Administration



The Department of Police Administration aims to train professionals who can protect the lives and safety of people as well as the order in society. For this purpose, we provide theoretical courses on the Constitution, Criminal Codes, Criminal Procedure Act, Police Administration Act, and other laws, as well as criminology, criminal psychology, juvenile delinquency, international crimes, crime prevention strategies, community policing, crime investigation, HR management, and more. In addition, we provide practical courses in apprehension self-defense and police work practices to develop professionals with both expertise and practical skills.

The courses include field trips, lectures by experts, and lectures by graduates. These assist our students in finding careers in various areas within courts, public prosecutor's offices, penitentiary and correctional facilities, and other parts of criminal law enforcement, in addition to the police force. Apart from classes, our students can enjoy extra-curricular activities to study for TOEIC or become a judo black belt, etc. Also, they can join 'Hanadoem,' a social volunteer work circle of the Department of Police Administration, to develop leadership in serving others. Our programs include field trips to related agencies such as police stations, courthouses, prisons, etc., and there is a specialized study room for students to focus on preparing related national exams.

There is a strong bond between all faculty members and students, and with one-to-one consultations, the faculty members do best to ensure all students reach their goals and realize their dreams.

Career Paths after Graduation

Our students find their career paths in various fields such as police officers, general civil servants, court officials, civil servants at public prosecutor's offices, court security officers, correctional officers, private investigators, and private security guards.



Department of Social Welfare



The Department of Social Welfare strives to train welfare professionals who are equipped with expertise and skills needed to understand and solve the problems in modern society, serving various demands in line with the changing trends in society. To qualify for a 1st Class Social Worker License and other educational programs, we offer ten mandatory courses. In addition, we offer license test courses for health and family service professionals. Upon graduation, our students can find career opportunities at social welfare agencies or as in civil service roles.

Career Paths after Graduation

Students who successfully complete the Department of Social Welfare's courses are automatically granted a 2nd Class Social Worker License, which enables them to apply for a 1st Class Social Worker License administered by the government. The Social Worker License program indicates the need in our society for professional social workers, and the program recognizes the status of social workers by the law to ensure their qualifications. In addition, we have a curriculum for health and family service professionals. Students who complete this course can obtain a Health and Family Service Professional License.



School of Global Languages

The School of Global Languages aims to educate talents who can lead the process of globalization based on their linguistic skills and knowledge of cultures. The school consists of the Department of English Language and the Department of Chinese Language. It is our goal to prepare intellectuals who will be able to communicate effectively with the world by learning English, the most widely spoken language, and Chinese, the most spoken language by population.

Department of English Language



The Department of English Language seeks to cultivate individuals who can become leaders in the global era. We train experts with a broad knowledge base and practical skills rooted in their English language proficiency. Students gain a comprehensive understanding of the linguistic, cultural, and practical aspects of English, enabling them to become skilled global leaders. The Department of English educates students who are capable of creative and critical thinking. Our English curriculum focuses on maximizing communication skills, strengthening practical skills in global businesses and international relationships, and enhancing cultural understanding and multicultural social adaptability. We provide a comprehensive curriculum that balances theoretical learning with practical experience to achieve this goal. Additionally, the department offers a variety of specialized programs, including language training abroad, exchange student opportunities, internships (both domestic and international), and English presentation competitions. The department has a vision called 'Flare' to provide more opportunities to students while providing a passionate and future-oriented direction.

Career Paths after Graduation

Graduates of the Department of English may find employment in various fields around the world that relate to the English language and translation/interpretation services, as well as in other areas such as English education, diplomatic careers, international business, general business, and public agencies.

Department of Chinese Language



The Department of Chinese Language is dedicated to the cultivation of global talents capable of thriving in various fields, including Korea–China exchange. This is achieved by providing them with the necessary skills in the Chinese language, as well as expertise in China and humanity. The department's objective is to address the growing engagement with China and the increasing importance of the Chinese language, which has become a key global language in the 21st century—an era interconnected by big data and artificial intelligence. Students benefit from well-organized industry–academic cooperation programs and are guided so that they can gain practical experience in the industry prior to graduation.

Our multi-faceted academic and cultural exchange activities include partnering with over 20 universities in the Chinese-speaking world, including China and Taiwan, to send exchange students, participate in language training programs, and organize global cultural expeditions annually.

Career Paths after Graduation

Students may pursue employment with the central government or local governments as civil servants with responsibilities for international exchanges, or with Chinese companies located in South Korea, South Korean companies undertaking business in China, broadcasting networks, and other organizations. Our graduates have the potential to make a significant contribution to the trade and exchange endeavors with China in a variety of sectors, including financial institutions, trade companies, airline operators, travel agencies, hotels, media, and publishing businesses.



School of Information Technology

As society advances into a technology-driven future, the School of Information Technology is committed to training field-oriented engineers who can lead in this rapidly evolving landscape. To achieve this, we offer a comprehensive curriculum that integrates both theoretical foundations in Computer Science and Engineering and hands-on laboratory and practical training.

Our students gain real-world experiences through field training and internships across various industries. We place strong emphasis on industry-academic collaboration programs, ensuring that our graduates are well-prepared for their chosen careers.

To foster innovation and adaptability, we have established a state-of-the-art educational environment, enabling students to stay ahead with emerging technologies and advanced knowledge. Rather than focusing on single-discipline majors, we emphasize Information Technology Convergence studies, equipping our students with interdisciplinary expertise that meets the demands of the modern digital world.

Department of Computer Engineering



Computer Engineering is a dynamic and ever-evolving study that explores innovative technologies to solve real-world problems. Our department offers a systematic and well-structured curriculum that focuses on the development of systems and software, alongside key areas such as advanced algorithms, data structures, computer architecture, operating systems, databases, software engineering, networks, big data, and artificial intelligence.

We emphasize a balanced approach that integrates both theoretical knowledge and hands-on practical training, ensuring that students can effectively implement modern technologies. Our curriculum covers foundational topics such as computer programming, algorithms, data structures, linear algebra, computer architecture, operating systems, databases, software engineering, networks, big data, and artificial intelligence. Our project-centered programs enhance practical skills and problem-solving abilities, preparing students for real-world challenges. We continuously explore innovative technologies and innovations, equipping students with expertise to thrive in an ever-changing technological landscape.

Career Paths after Graduation

Graduates from the Department of Computer Engineering have a wide range of career opportunities across various industries: Software Developers, System Engineers, Data Analysts, Network Experts, Security Experts, AI Experts, Mobile Application Developers, Researchers, and Entrepreneurs.

Department of Convergence Security



The Department of Convergence Security is dedicated to training highly skilled professionals who can protect an organization's critical resources from technical infringements, threats, and cybercrimes in diverse environments. To achieve this, our curriculum integrates innovative engineering technologies with legal and criminological knowledge, preparing students to tackle security challenges from multiple perspectives. Core Areas of Study: Encryption, security protocols, breach analysis and response, digital forensics, cloud security, authentication systems, 4th Industrial Revolution Technologies: AI, big data, cloud computing, emerging digital innovations, Intellectual property law, personal information protection, trade secret protection, white-collar and digital crime investigations, criminal psychology. Through this interdisciplinary approach, we aim to cultivate creative and field-ready convergence security professionals who can effectively address technical, legal, and criminal security challenges.

Career Paths after Graduation

Convergence Security is a rapidly growing and highly promising field, offering diverse career opportunities: Convergence Security Experts, specializing in integrated security solutions across industries, Information & Cybersecurity Specialists, Technical Security Engineers, Industrial Security & Defense Security Analysts, Public Sector & Law Enforcement, IT & Communication Industries, and Entrepreneurs.

With a solid foundation in engineering, law, and criminology, graduates of the Department of Convergence Security are well-equipped to become leaders in the evolving security industry.



School of Liberal Studies

In this era of the 4th Industrial Revolution, characterized by rapid changes and great uncertainties, convergent thinking skills and expertise are required for multifaceted problem-solving. The School has been established for the purpose of allowing students to explore a variety of academic disciplines, after which they can select their major and seek a career path. In their first year, the students can explore various interdisciplinary subjects and extra-curricular programs. In addition, they take liberal arts courses to decide their major and career plan. Specifically, students participate in the Academic Advising program, student mentoring, major-exploration seminars, and career exploration programs to discover their aptitude before they select their major as they proceed to the second year.

In this process, students develop the convergent skills necessary to think from different angles and respond to their problems in a creative manner. Moreover, they have the autonomy to choose the career paths and majors that best suit them, allowing them to become proactive professionals equipped to meet the demands of future society.

School of Performing Arts

The School of Performing Arts aims to educate students who engage with the world through creative and professional artistic activities as artists rooted in Christianity and sound personalities.

The students contribute to a more beautiful world by promoting culture within their communities and providing emotional enrichment to society. Through an art education that emphasizes academic achievement, rigorous practical training, diverse coursework, and emotional development—essential elements in modern society—the School cultivates skilled artists who can respond to contemporary demands as intellectuals with global insights. Students develop a comprehensive understanding of artistic creativity and social responsibility and grow their skills in creative problem-solving. In addition, they are offered various opportunities to study abroad as well as take part in international exchange programs in line with the global era, as we help them develop into talents with an international sense of competitiveness. By using an international art network, we expand the opportunities for our students to shine in the international theater and develop an environment where they can experience multicultural sentiments and artistic diversity. We offer well-structured curricula and mentoring programs, enabling students to apply their artistic talents in theater, visual arts, music education, and other fields. Furthermore, we have established a strong network to support their continued artistic growth beyond graduation.

Department of Music



The Department of Music aims to train musicians who possess both artistic creativity and professional expertise. We offer a variety of majors, including piano, vocal, composing, editing, and orchestra. Our curriculum, which integrates academic theory with practical training, helps students develop well-rounded musical proficiency. Our musicians are trained to achieve expertise through the convergence of advanced practical skills, theories, art, and the humanities, as they can achieve advanced skills and knowledge in the fields of their major.

Additionally, our graduates are educated as musicians who have characters that are considerate of others and understand the values of music in sharing and serving. As a result, they engage in service and community activities, using music as a medium. Amid the rapid evolution of industrial society, we help them develop creative enabling them to explore the diverse roles of music and expand their artistic capabilities independently. They also gain expertise in digital music production and multimedia integration—essential skills for the modern music industry. We train musicians to serve the country and local communities through a variety of musical activities and provide social outreach programs such as musical concerts for community enrichment and educational volunteer opportunities. Our curricula are also highly organized, from basic, intensive, advanced, and expert courses for each school year.

In the first year, students build a strong foundation by learning music theory and fundamental practical skills. Second-year students deepen their expertise through advanced coursework in their major and hands-on practice, while third-year students engage in creative and performance projects to gain practical experience. In the fourth year, students present their graduation projects and performances as they work to establish their unique musical style.

Piano majors study a diverse range of piano repertoires while developing skills in solo performance, accompaniment, and ensemble playing. Vocal majors receive individual coaching to refine their vocalization and expression while also participating in opera and choir performances.

Composition and editing majors explore modern composition techniques, computer music production, film and TV scoring, and various other fields. Orchestra majors enhance their ensemble performance experience while developing professional-level proficiency in their respective instruments. The Department of Music is dedicated to supporting students from multiple perspectives, helping them unlock their full musical potential and ultimately grow into artists who contribute to society.



Career Paths after Graduation

Our graduates can find career opportunities as professional performers, musical researchers, educators, artistic managers, and more. Also, they can find jobs in other related areas, such as music reporters, PDs, DJs, or writers related to classical music broadcasting, art management, musical therapy, positions in national or municipal choirs, orchestras, or choir conductors, as well as any other areas related to music. Our alumni are achieving successful careers as chamber music performers, music producers, music directors for movies or TV shows, music technology experts, and other areas related to modern music. In the field of music education, our graduates serve as music teachers in elementary, middle, and high schools; college instructors; or faculty members to educate the next generation of musicians. Some of them also run private music lesson centers to participate in the music education industry. In addition, they can develop their careers as project managers, performance planners, or art directors in music-related industries such as art and culture agencies or production companies. Based on their creative musical skills, our graduates participate in the development of new genres or convergent content to expand the possibilities of music. In addition, some of our graduates venture into the world to be a part of a foreign orchestra or choir or compete in global music festivals or contests to have their musical capabilities recognized.

Department of Art & Theater



The Department of Art & Theater trains students to develop the aptitudes and skills essential for performing arts, preparing them to become elite professionals in the fields of culture and art. In addition to training in performance, dance, and vocal techniques, students receive intensive instruction in other essential skills required for their respective fields, ensuring a strong foundation in the fundamentals. Our faculty consists of renowned and active professionals from both academia and industry, providing a well-balanced education that integrates theory and practice. Through this approach, we cultivate versatile entertainers who are both creative and highly skilled professionals.



Career Paths after Graduation

Our graduates can work as professionals in art and culture and find career paths not only as musical performers but also actors, theater educators, directors, composers, editors, music directors, or staff members.

School of Design

With the transition from the industrial age to the information age, design education is becoming increasingly specialized, segmented, and professional. In response to this trend, we established the departments of Visual Information Design, Interior Architecture Design, and Textile Fashion Design to train professionals who possess both practical skills and cultural creativity in their respective fields. We have introduced state-of-the-art educational equipment and systems.
